

**Call for Papers to iKAR 2027 issue (3/2027)  
on competition protection and sectoral regulation**

**I. The Centre for Antitrust and Regulatory Studies (CARs)**, operating within the Faculty of Management at the University of Warsaw, invites authors to submit texts for the next issue of the **"internet Antitrust and Regulatory Quarterly"** (iKAR) dedicated to **competition protection and sectoral regulation**.

This issue of iKAR will focus on the topics of competition protection and sectoral regulation (with the proviso that issue 1/2027 of iKAR will be dedicated to energy regulation).

**II.** Submitted manuscripts may address, for example, the following topics:

- goals of competition law,
- prohibition of anti-competitive agreements,
- prohibition of abuse of a dominant position,
- merger control,
- foreign subsidies control,
- state aid,
- prohibition of unfair use of contractual advantage/superior bargaining power,
- regulation of electronic communications and postal services,
- rail transport regulation,
- regulation of the water and sewage market,
- regulation of e-commerce platforms,
- Digital Markets Act,
- Artificial Intelligence Act.

We warmly invite authors to submit texts devoted to these issues from substantive law, procedural, institutional perspectives and/or other perspectives. The above issues may be presented in scientific articles concerning EU law, national law, or from a comparative law perspective.

**III. Texts may take the form of:**

- **scientific articles;**

- **reviews of law, case law** from courts and/or competition authorities;
- **case commentaries or annotations** on judgments of EU or national courts;
- **reports** from significant events in areas within iKAR's scope;
- **reviews** of national or foreign publications.

**IV.** Texts should be submitted **through the Editorial Manager system** available on the iKAR website under the [Submit Article](#) tab in the left-hand menu.

Texts submitted for this issue should comply with iKAR's [editorial standards](#) and [ethical guidelines](#). Submitted articles must include an abstract and a list of keywords in both Polish and English, JEL code(s) and statement on the scope of use of AI tools. Authors are also asked to provide an English title. Each article should also include a note indicating the author's affiliation, an ORCID number and an email address for publication.

Articles are subject to double-blind peer review in accordance with the [review guidelines](#) adopted by the editorial board.

**V.** We invite submissions from **academic staff**, including doctoral students, and **professionals** (judges, attorneys, legal advisors, legal and economic consultants) interested in the subject matter of the journal.

**VI.** The issue 3/2027 will be published in the **third quarter of 2027**.

**The deadline for submitting texts in the system is 28 December 2026.**
